


Tip Guide: OneView Reports Module - Advanced Features



Click the **Reports tab** located in the team toolbar to access the Reports Module.



After clicking the **Reports tab**, the **Reports module** will open up in another tab. You will be able to access your Personal collection, as well as Standard reports.



Helpful Tip: All of the data in these reports is pulled directly from your Team. The more complete your profiles are, the better your reporting experience will be.

Tip Guide: ORM Advanced Features - Conditional Formatting



Conditional formatting is a feature that lets you visually highlight data in tables based off of specific rules or condition. It is used to mark important patterns, trends, or outliers stand out.


After selecting the report you'd like to run, click the **gear icon** to access conditional formatting. This feature allows you to add rules to make cells within the report change color.

Conditional Formatting:

- 1. From the dropdown, select which column(s) you would like to be affected.
- 2. You can refine your results by selecting options such as "is equal to," "contains," and others to filter by a specific column value.
- 3. Choose the color you'd like to use for highlighting the cells.
- 4. To highlight the entire row, simply toggle this option on.
- 5. Select "Add Rule" to apply the updates to your report.
- 6. When you've finished adding rules to the cells, click Done.

Note: Highlights made to the cells will not be included in the exported report.





Merging Reports: This feature lets you combine two or more existing questions (reports), based on a shared column, allowing you to view all data points together in a single report.

Click **New** in the upper right-hand corner and then Select **Question**.




Next, select **Tables** and then choose the folder where your report is located. Now, select the report.







Click the **combine icon** to include another report.




Select **Table**, choose the folder where your report is located, and then select the report that you would like to join.
















Visualizations: While tables are useful for looking up information or finding specific numbers, it's usually easier to see trends and make sense of data using charts.




Tip Guide: ORM Advanced Features - Creating a Dashboard







Adding New Reports to a Dashboard: After you name and save your customized report, a pop-up will appear asking if you'd like to add the report to a dashboard. If so, select "Yes please!"

Next, choose the dashboard where you'd like to save it. Once you've made your selection, click **"Select"** to have the report populate on the chosen dashboard.









From the dropdown menu, select "**Pin this.**" You'll then see your pinned reports and dashboards displayed at the top of your personal collection.
