



Accessing and Running OneView Web Reports




Web reports serve as an interactive dashboard. They provide an overall snapshot of your teams data that can be used for various credentialing solutions. Access web reports in the reports dropdown located next to the OneView V2 button as show here.



Use the blank search boxes seen going across to enter the information or select from the drop-down to filter your report.

The profile names seen here are a direct link to that profile.



When you click a number in the column, a pop-up will show the items tied to that profile. For example, selecting "1" under Logins displays the stored login, and selecting a number under Documents shows the list of documents in that profile.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is a good use case for utilizing the Web Reports?

Web Reports provide an interactive snapshot of all profiles on your team. They let you view and work with profile data, quickly navigate into profiles, and are especially helpful for monitoring onboarding invitations, recredentialing with facilities, payor updates, and license statuses.

Q: Can read only coordinator profiles see Web Reports? No, only full access coordinators have access to CSV and Web

reports.




